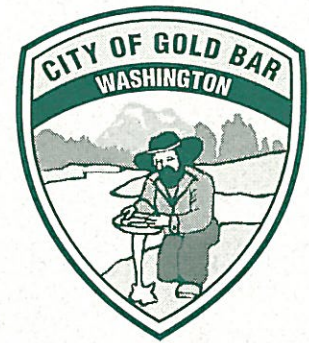

City of Gold Bar Council Meeting Minutes Saturday, February 19, 2011

CALL TO ORDER, FLAG SALUTE, ROLL CALL

Mayor Beavers called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. Council members Broyles, Lie and Prueher were present.

1. ORDINANCE REVIEW

Title 8

8.04.010 - Duties of residents.

There was discussion on whether garbage cans should be visible from the street and on windblown debris. Council member Broyles is to check on the sizes of available garbage cans.

Council member Martin now present at 10:15 AM.

8.04.060 - Trucks and equipment to be approved for use.

Mayor Beavers is to check with Allied Waste about windblown debris.

8.12.040 - Litter—Prohibited.

The item D which supposes a City jurisdiction on the Gold Bar recycling site (assumed to be the closed transfer station) is to be deleted when this title is updated.

8.12.090 - Mandatory litter bags.

Is this a State law and should it be deleted when this title is updated. Council member Lie to compare this against the Model Traffic Ordinance.

8.12.110 - Litter thrown from vehicles unlawful.

Is this a State law and should it be deleted when this title is updated. Council member Lie to compare this against the Model Traffic Ordinance.

8.16.020 - Public nuisance defined.

Does D apply to snow parking? Public Works Director Light to review.

8.16.030 - Public nuisances affecting health.

Change "abandoned" to "unused" in J when this title is updated.

Item M is covered already by 8.04.010 C it seems.

By motion of council member Lie and Martin to adjourn for lunch. Motion passed.

8.16.050 - Public nuisances affecting peace and safety.

Item Y is an expansive adder to 8.17.

Chapter 8.20 - FIREWORKS

Add a variance paragraph for special events and eliminate the toy pistol restriction.

Council member Lie to propose a rewrite of this ordinance to be used when this title is updated.

Title 8 - HEALTH AND SAFETY

Council member Broyles is to review the referenced RCWs to see if they still apply.

Title 9

Chapter 9.04 - DRUG PARAPHERNALIA

Mayor Beavers to check with Chief Martin to see if this chapter is required or if it is best superseded by a State regulation.

Chapter 9.10 - CURFEW

Delete this chapter when this title is updated.

Title 10

10.08.010 - General weight limitations.

This chapter was evidently written before May Creek Road was annexed. Needs to consider other roads and add buses to the allowed vehicles. Actual truck weights need to be reviewed.

Title 2

2.16.070 - Blanket bond.

City Clerk Treasurer Kelly to check if the blanket bond is active or if it has been replaced with some other coverage.

Title 12

12.08.020 - Restrictions.

There was discussion about park restrictions and a trespass letter. Mayor Beavers is to talk to Chief Martin about his US-2 Park suggestions. This subject is planned for discussion at the next two council meetings.

Chapter 12.10 - TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Mayor Beavers is to see if new rules apply to this chapter.

Title 13

Public Works Director Light is to review Title 13 for any needed changes.

13.04.245 - Water service connections in the floodplain.

Public Works Director Light is to review this chapter specifically.

13.08.010 - Authority over sources of supply.

City Clerk Treasurer Kelly to look for Exhibit A referenced in the ordinance.


Title 15
