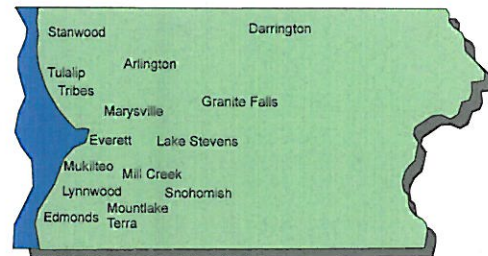

Dear Mayor Beavers:

Your city's past support of the Snohomish County Tomorrow (SCT) Program has helped make it possible for this organization to fulfill the planning requirements and mandates of the State Growth Management Act. The Steering Committee forum continues to provide an excellent opportunity for elected officials from the cities, the towns, the County and the tribes to come together in a collaborative manner to address growth management, transportation and other issues of regional importance.

On February 1, 2012, the Steering Committee approved the 2012 dues structure, including a small increase in dues to partially offset expenditures. This small increase recognizes the economic challenges many jurisdictions are facing right now while also taking into account the need to eventually balance revenues with expenditures. As in past years, the dues structure is based on an adjusted per capita scale for various population ranges. The Association of Washington Cities' dues structure formula was adopted by the Steering Committee in 1989 as an equitable method to fund the annual SCT work plans and programs.
