UTILITY WORKER I

GENERAL STATEMENT

Under direct supervision of the Public Works Director and general supervision of the Utility II Lead Position, the Utility Worker I is responsible for general maintenance and repair of the City water system, streets, parks, municipal buildings and other facilities. Involves the operation and maintenance of equipment and vehicles used in areas of assignment.

EXAMPLES OF WORK.

Duties include, but are not limited to: Reads water meters and records usage, maintains right of ways and utility easements, maintains fire hydrants, storage tanks, and other system facilities, repairs and installs service lines and meters, repairs and installs service mains, takes water samples as directed and monitors water system equipment.

Performs excavations, minor street repairs, install street signs: operation of mowers to maintain all facilities and right of ways: operation of Backhoe, Endloader and Dump Truck to haul material, grade roads and execute construction projects; operation of light equipment such as power tools, chain saws, compressor, generator, etc.; operation of standard Passenger Vehicles, Tractor and Snow Plow.

Performs general janitorial and maintenance work on Municipal Buildings and Grounds, including weeding, painting, cleaning and making minor repairs as directed.

May perform work with animal control issues, perform building and development site inspections, assist in Municipal Code enforcement and be required to respond to emergency's within the City, such as water system failure. Will be required to work closely with the public on a daily basis.

Performs related tasks as assigned.
