**A RESOLUTION FOR MODIFICATION
TO THE 2005 GOLD BAR COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan specified improvements to City Parks;
and

WHEREAS the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan specified providing facilities such as picnic areas and shelters (PTR-P15); and

WHEREAS, the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan specified considering the level of use and ease of maintenance of recreation equipment (PTR-P19); and

WHEREAS the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan specified providing for recreational and cultural programs (PTR-P35 to PTR-P38); and

WHEREAS, the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan specified funding for development and improvement of the designated City Parks; and

WHEREAS, Gold Bar has developed a summer program consisting of multiple events that meet the criteria noted above; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Gold Bar, Washington as follows:

1. The City Council finds that the attached equipment list meet the intent of the 2005 Gold Bar Comprehensive Plan.
2. The equipment specified for “All Parks” meets the needs of the summer events, particularly to the level of use and ease of maintenance.
3. The City Council approves the expenditures noted in the attached equipment list and approves the use of Park Impact Fees for them.
